NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Clerk, at City Hall, 100 East Santa Fe, in Olathe, Kansas, until 2:00 p.m. local time, on October 14, 2008 for the construction of 143rd Sanitary Sewer, Lakeshore Meadows West, Project 1-B-001-07.

At said time and place, and promptly thereafter, all bids that have been duly received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work consists of the following:

The construction of a 42" Hobas Sanitary Sewer Main. Beginning 3,500 Ft East of Cedar Niles North to half section line. The improvements shall include approximately 2,600 LF. ~ 42" Hobas Gravity Sewer main; restoration and all appurtenant and necessary work to complete the project.

Contract Documents including drawings and specifications are on file at the office of the City Engineer of Olathe, Kansas, and are open for public inspections. Copies may be obtained at the office of Level-4 Engineering, LLC 11490 Strang Line Road Lenexa KS 66215, (913)-317-9500, for thirty dollars (\$30.00), none of which will be refunded.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the City of Governors Meeting Room on First Floor, at City Hall, 100 East Santa Fe, in Olathe, Kansas at 10:00 a.m. local time on October 8, 2008. Attendance at this meeting is not mandatory, however, key aspects of the project will be discussed and representatives of the City and Engineer will be available to discuss the project.

The entire name of the project must appear on the outside of the bid envelope submitted to the City Clerk's office.

A satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and an acceptable surety, in an amount equal to 5 percent (5%) of the total bid for work shall be submitted with each proposal.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish and pay satisfactory performance and payment bond or bonds.

The City of Olathe, Kansas, reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Bids may be held by the City of Olathe, Kansas, for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of the opening of bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of bidders, prior to awarding the contract.

Effective April 24, 2000, all bidders shall submit in writing to the Director of Human Relations an affirmative action program. No contract will be awarded to any company that has not been issued a Certification of Compliance by the Olathe Human Relations Commission within the past twelve months. A copy of the required form is included in the contract documents.
